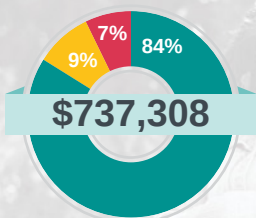
OUR MISSION AND VISION

We exist to promote life through Christ to those vulnerable to abortion. Our vision is that every individual in our community would choose physical life for their unborn children, eternal life through faith in Christ, and abundant life by walking in obedience to Him.

Founded in 1990, Assist Pregnancy Center is a Christian, 501(c)(3) non-profit organization guided by a local Board of Directors. Because of generous donors, all of our life-affirming medical and support services for women and men in our community are free. In addition to direct clinic services, Assist partners with local churches through outreach, training, and education.



TOTAL REVENUE IN 2017

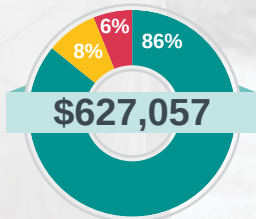


- INDIVIDUAL GIFTS: 84%

More than 60 volunteers contributed over \$62,000 in volunteer hours in 2017. Expectant parents were equipped with over \$16,000 in essential baby supplies donated as in-kind gifts.

Funding came from 1182 individuals, 26 local churches, and 21 businesses and organizations in 2017. Assist receives no government funding, making your generosity vital for sustaining the Center's life-saving work.

- DEVELOPMENT: 6%

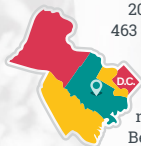


WHY WE SERVE

On average, 6,000 abortions occur annually in Northern Virginia. That is 15 abortions every single day—abortions ending lives and leaving individuals with pain and regret. Assist provides practical care so that families facing an unplanned pregnancy are empowered to make a better choice than abortion. In 2017, six out of ten of our at-risk clients chose life for their unborn children because of the services you made possible.



In 2017, we shared the need to add a fifth day of operations in order to meet growing demand for services. Thanks to your support, in January 2018, we began operating five days a week, meeting a strategic regional need by becoming the only pregnancy medical center open on Fridays in Northern Virginia.



2017 marked our busiest year on record, with 463 distinct clients accessing medical services to confirm pregnancy, receiving decision making support, and experiencing ongoing mentoring. Clients came from 57 different nations, 10 counties in Virginia, and various Beltway communities in D.C. and Maryland.
