Opportunities to See Your Church Partner

- Counsel women and men on their options during pregnancy decisions as a male or female client mentor
- Provide medical care to families as a volunteer RN, RDMS, PA, APRN, or MD
- Coach expectant moms and dads in the Center's education program as a male or female client mentor
- Help facilitate group education classes as a hospitality, set-up, or class administration volunteer
- Prepare and host baby showers at the Center for new parents as a resource volunteer
- Make care accessible to all patients as a translation volunteer (Spanish, Arabic high priorities)
- Help women and men find hope after a past abortion as an abortion recovery Bible Study facilitator

Opportunities to serve patients typically require a minimum weekly commitment during the day, following initial application, orientation, and training. Limited evening opportunities are available for male and female client mentors and medical professionals.

- Clean the facility as a cleaning team member
- Deliver general office and database support as an administrative volunteer
- Help the clinic operate well as a building maintenance volunteer
- Support spring and fall ministry fundraising events as an event volunteer
- Use your talents as a videography, photography, or graphic design volunteer
- Provide professional expertise as an interior designer, architect, building engineer, or contractor to a special committee working on the Center's space expansion

- Host a gathering with your men's or women's ministry to introduce the ministry through a speaker or video resources from Assist
- Form a team to participate in the annual Assist Walk/Run/Ride for Life (fun run and bike event) on Saturday of Mother's Day weekend
