• Funding came from 1,072 individuals, 27 local churches, and 37 businesses and organizations in 2020. Assist **receives no government funding**, making your generosity vital for sustaining the Center's life-saving work.

• More than 75 volunteers contributed over \$32,000 in volunteer hours in 2020. Expectant parents were equipped with \$30,000 in essential baby supplies donated as in-kind gifts.

Restricted Building & Project Donations: \$726,456 Special capital gifts funded the purchase of additional building space and equipment. Restricted funds will help. **501-D** support the Build Life 2021 building expansion campaign.

WHY ASSIST SERVES

Nearly 21,000 abortions occur annually in the D.C. region, one of the few areas in the country where abortion is available throughout all 40 weeks of pregnancy. Assist works to reach those facing an unexpected pregnancy with no-cost medical and counseling care so parents are empowered to embrace their child and know hope in Jesus. In 2020, the majority of women undecided about their pregnancy chose life after visiting the Center.

STAYING OPEN IN 2020

Your Impact During the COVID-19 Crisis: With abortion businesses booming during COVID-19, care was even more critical for those unexpectedly pregnant and facing job loss, school closures, and the isolation of lockdowns. By God's grace, the clinic stayed OPEN for in-person care during all twelve months of 2020. Though many other clinics halted operations due to COVID-19, Assist never once shut its doors for in-person medical care.

The addition of brand new tele-health services, new virtual mentoring programs, and special emergency diaper supplies and grocery gift card funds to meet practical needs helped rescue even more lives and sustain families.



EXPANDING ASSIST'S REACH IN 2021

Doubling Clinic Space to Double Life Impact: With a 250% increase in clients since the start of the Center's medical services in 2013, the need for more clinic space had become a pressing need in 2020. After a year of prayer and research, Assist's Board of Directors began planning for growth so the Center could reach more families visiting the three abortion businesses all located within 6 miles of the Center. God then worked in a mighty way through the generosity of special ministry partners to make possible the debt-free purchase in December 2020 of an adjacent office unit perfectly situated to allow for immediate growth in our current space.

With the BUILD LIFE 2021 expansion campaign starting late spring 2021, extensive renovation in our current and newly acquired units will **double** clinic and counseling space to allow more families at-risk of abortion to find real help at Assist.
